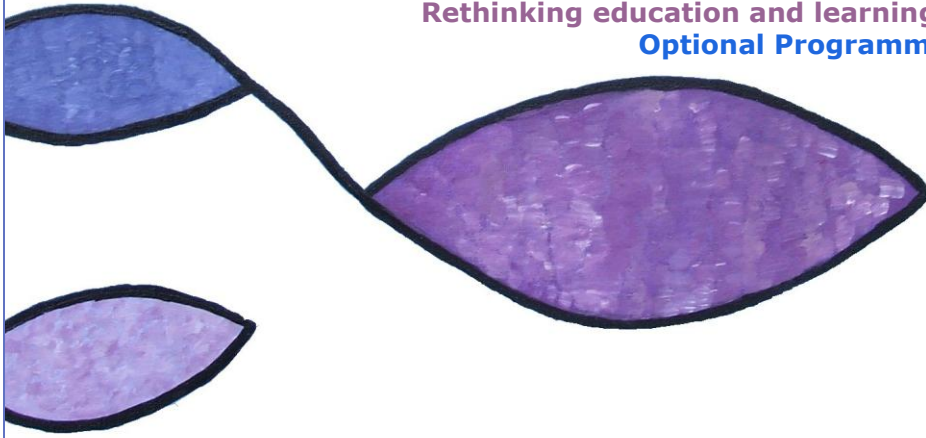


**Crossing Boundaries and Expanding Horizons**
